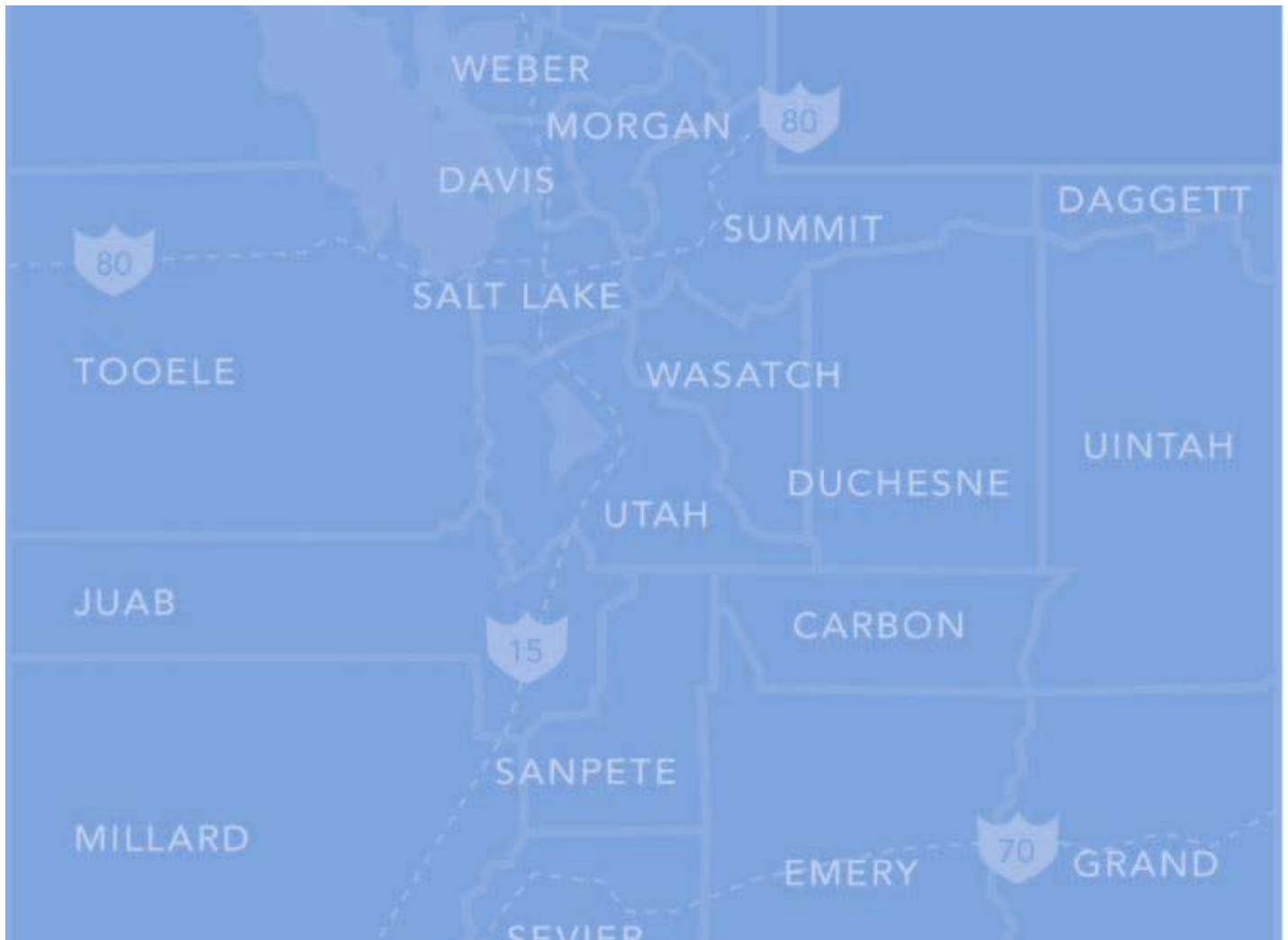

## MAJOR RECENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Daggett County is working to update the County General Plan including the Dutch John area. The county is working with Aspen Rivers, LLC, a team of specialized planners, to evaluate existing plans and improve the implementation ability and create a clearer path to develop a sustainable economy. The update will provide a better outline and guidance for the county through the year 2030. Public meetings will be held throughout the process.<sup>1</sup>
- The Uintah Basin Medical Center Clinic opened on July 13, 2007. The reopening of the clinic was the result of a partnership between TriCounty Health, Daggett County and the Uintah Basin Medical Center. Equipment and renovations for the facility were partially funded by the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board. Dental and basic health services are now provided.<sup>2</sup>
