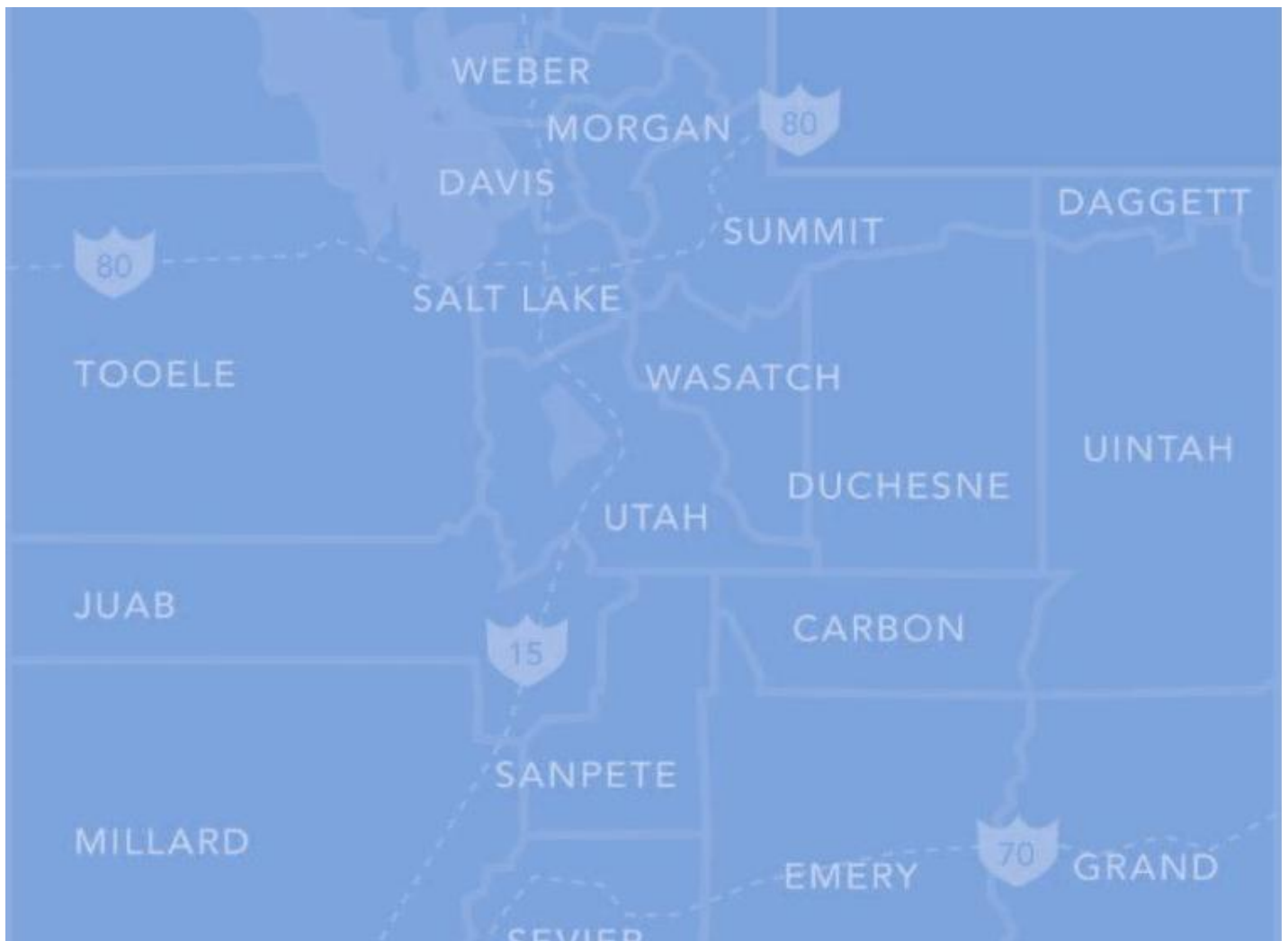

MAJOR RECENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Daggett County is working to update the County General Plan including the Dutch John area. The county is working with Aspen Rivers, LLC, a team of specialized planners, to evaluate existing plans and improve the implementation ability and create a clearer path to develop a sustainable economy. The update will provide a better outline and guidance for the county through the year 2030. Public meetings will be held throughout the process.¹
- The Uintah Basin Medical Center Clinic opened on July 13, 2007. The reopening of the clinic was the result of a partnership between TriCounty Health, Daggett County and the Uintah Basin Medical Center. Equipment and renovations for the facility were partially funded by the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board. Dental and basic health services are now provided.²

RECREATION

Flaming Gorge National Recreation Area	The Flaming Gorge Reservoir extends 91 miles west and north of the Flaming Gorge Dam and provides excellent boating, water skiing, fishing and other recreational activities.
Green River	The Green River below the Flaming Gorge Dam is an internationally renowned tailwater fishery. Surveys indicate this stretch of river has the most fish per mile of any river in the United States. Rafting and kayaking are also very popular on the river. A popular hiking trail follows the river 7 miles downstream from the Dam to the first takeout point.
Ashley National Forest	The USFS has many camp sites and areas of dispersed camping to enjoy within Daggett County. The forest is full of a wide variety of wildlife and recreational opportunities including hiking, biking and ATV riding.
Flaming Gorge National Scenic Byway	Hwy 191 out of Vernal and Hwy 44 in Manila form the lower end of this beautiful Scenic Byway. There are campgrounds along the way and Scenic Backways to get you even more off the beaten path.
Bureau of Land Management	The Eastern part of the County has large acreages of BLM managed lands that are available for a variety of recreational uses including fishing, hiking, biking and camping.
