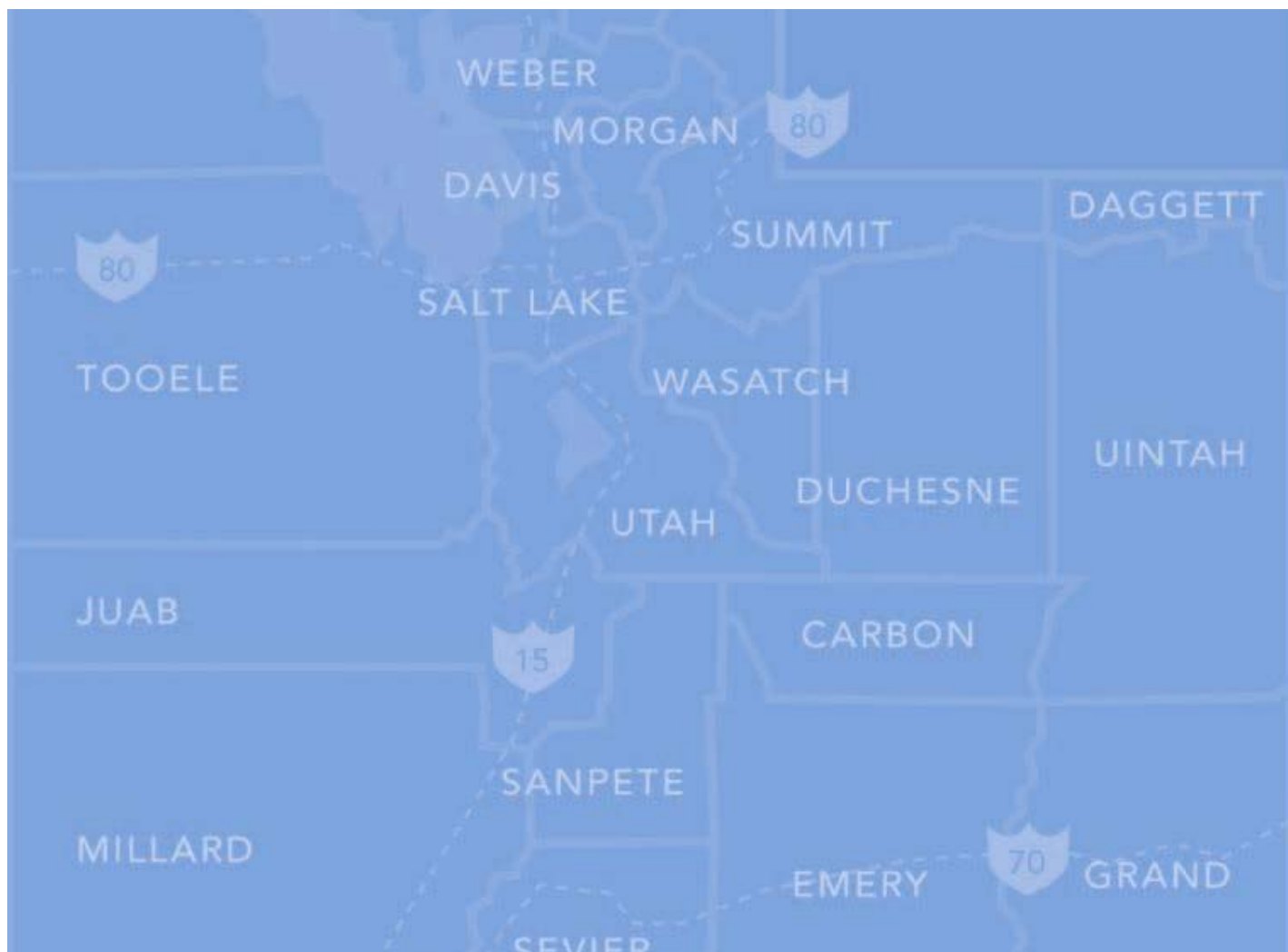

MAJOR RECENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Duchesne County is one of five counties in Utah eligible to participate in a new federal program designed to bring in prospective teachers into the classroom. The county will be able to take advantage of \$1.4 million in federal funds through the No Child Left Behind Act to pay approved applicants to receive training and become teachers.¹

Uintah Mountains	The Uintah Mountains offer great views and the highest peak in all of Utah, King's Peak at a towering 13,528 feet.

Starvation State Park	Starvation reservoir, just a few miles from Duchesne, provides recreation activities such as fishing, camping, boating, and other water activities.
